Lithium Republic XYZ

Lithium Republic XYZ is a rehearsal in the metaverse about the territory known as the lithium triangle (located in the wetlands region between Chile, Bolivia, and Argentina). Through the virtual twin of environments in crisis, the project aims to support interdisciplinary research that addresses the current situation in that space, as well as gather information about the complex web that forms between the future of energy, geohumanities, and indigenous critic.

Lithium Republic XYZ Why?

The lithium region is physically hard-to-reach, and most people are unaware of it. Nevertheless, it has become the focal point of one of the most pressing agenda issues of the moment: the energetic transition. Creating an image of the place, its inhabitants, the diversity of voices, worldviews, and temporalities situated there, is a first step towards forming a stance that allows us to reflect on and take action regarding a seemingly elusive problem.

The potential images of this region are far too intricate and profound to be seen singularly. Its wealth in resources, stories, and culture cannot be fully interpreted all at once. However, the lithium triangle is not an uninhabited desert, as is often depicted.

Lithium Republic XYZ presents itself as a platform enabling the staging of different questions and discourses about this crisis-ridden environment, utilizing resources such as virtuality and simulation.

The project support researchers and individuals interested in this region and related issues, who aims to explore the potential of these language tools for reflection, dissemination, and the rehearsal of alternative narratives, thus constructing potential realities. While its purpose is the appropriation of new media (metaverse, VR, blockchain, AI) for experimental purposes, to de-hierarchize virtual discourses—emanating from hegemonic centers of power—favoring participation and decentralization.

Presenting Lithium Republic XYZ in Barcelona: Talking + Q&A

Title: Lithium Republic XYZ - Virtual Territory (Talking)
Subtitle: Rehearsing realities on metaverse for change.

The presentation of this project consists of a **40-minute talk** where we will cover the following:

- → Context of the addressed region: a brief overview of its historical, socio-political, and geographical aspects;
- → project fundamentals and roadmap;
- → applied practices: the first virtual twin (Salar del Hombre Muerto), 'Devorar el Trueno' (virtual exhibition), and research specific to the territory (video essay);
- next steps.

Finally, we will **open the floor to the audience**, allowing for questions.

Additionally, it is possible to **showcase the experience** of the first virtual twin, either within the same presentation or through VR headsets.


Needs:

- optional: VR headsets and computer.



Salar Flat



In her recent projects, she delves into the impact of technological abstraction on the political and affective aspects of society, exploring themes such as virtuality, language, complexity, and machine learning.

As an independent curator, she organized exhibitions in galleries, institutions, and universities in Buenos Aires, as well as internationally in galleries in New York and Berlin. Her texts have been published in platforms such as Artishock (Chile), SuperRare (USA), MoCA (USA), The Curated (UK), and featured in prominent books like Artificially Intelligent (V&A, UK), 10 años de Espacio Contemporáneo (PROA, Argentina), and ¿Dónde y cuándo termina un sitio web? (Flee Immediately, Argentina).
